the communication of policies to students, with student-specific policies going to the Dean of Students' website and being communicated through emails.

A new proposed Conflict of Interest Policy was also discussed, covering definitions of conflicts, disclosure, mitigation, and approval processes. There were queries about the definition of a faculty member's excessive or unauthorized use of university

Deferred to a subsequent meeting.
