Procedures

Individual students, faculty, staff, or program leaders who wish to travel to international regions identified as having a high level of risk to health and safety according to the agencies and organizations listed above, may petition for an exception to this policy

¹ Within this system, an overall country level can be either lower or higher than specific locations within that country. (Example: Colombia is a Level 2 but areas within the country are a Level 4. Specific locations determine whether travel is permitted or not. All participants and leaders who travel to Level 2 locations will receive a statement that highlights precautions listed in the Department of State Advisory. Similarly, countries can be at a
