ALL STUDENTS

Specific requirements for each degreefacend in the appropriate sections of the degreefacend and Graduate Catalogs.

The academic year begins on the first day of soften the summer term and ends on the last day of class the following spring term.

Academic advising is made availa to each student at the university. However, the student alone bears the primary responsibility for sating each university and program requirement. Any departure from the requirements stain the appropriate issue of toetalogmust be approved on a "Petition for Exception to Policy."

Before any degree can be certified by the Unityersegistrar, the student must complete an application for graduation and resplete all required coursework Degrees are posted as of the term in which the coursework is completed. Decentaries never back-dated to previous terms. Both graduate and undergraduate studental terms deficiencies (Policy 83-1).

UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS

The minimum number of credits required for undergraduate degree from attle University is 180 quarter credits, with the extrem of the Bachelor of Arts in lumanities degree. Certain programs may require more than 180 credits ader no circumstances will the total credits required for the degree be reduced.

The senior year must be spent in resident the tuniversity, which shall be understood to mean the final 45 credits of degree requirents. Such work is to be taken at the university under the direction of members of the falty. Under certain circums to this requirement may be waived with the approval of the dean or the dean's design (such as students in AFROTC, NROTC, and study abroad programs).

Students are held to the degrequirements in effect at thiene of matriculation unless a requirement cannot be met because of substantianges in departmental offerings. When previous requirements are no longer offered student's department chairperson and dean will prescribe major requirements where "Petition for Exception to longer." A student may request to graduate under degree requirements especified in a subsequentalog but cannot graduate under the requirements from an ear cartalog

Students who are readmitted or withcome majors are held toethajor or program and college

or school requirements infect at the time of renrollment or the change major or program. A student may request to graduate undegrete requirements special in a subseque catalog, but cannot graduate undeethequirement from an earlie Catalog

To transfer from one college **sc**hool to another or from one operation to another students must complete the Change of Major, Degree, **oe** splization form. Students must meet the minimum entry requirements of the new major or pargr and must also tissfy any additional requirements of the new college/**so** in order to earn the degree

All degree requirements for undergraduate studeshould be completed within 10 years of the date on which the college work was begun. Crever 10 years old wilknly apply to a degree when graded C (2.00) or betterrobapproved as applicable to the gree by the student's dean or department chair.

Cumulative grade point average (GPA) and creedituirements are stated for each program in the Catalogand in Policy 75-2. Only courses complete Seattle University are included in the GPA. The major GPA will include all Seattle University work used to complete the course and credit requirements of the majors well as the supporting course allied fields specifically required by the program.

When transfer courses applied to major requirembave fewer credits the SU equivalent, the total credits needed to complete the major requirements will be reduced by a maximum of one credit. However, the total credits
