HONORS AT GRADUATION For Undergraduate Students Only

Graduation with honors requires completion of at least 90 credits in residence at Seattle University. The minimum of 90 credits must be earned in regularly graded courses (courses in which the grades of A, B, C, D, or F are given). Should a student <u>elect</u> the pass/fail (P/F) option for any one course as part of the 90 credit minimum, eligibility for honors at graduation will be lost.
