

**HONORS AT GRADUATION
 For Undergraduate Students Only**

Graduation with honors requires completion of at least 90 credits in residence at Seattle University. The minimum of 90 credits must be earned in regularly graded courses (courses in which the grades of A, B, C, D, or F are given). Should a student elect the pass/fail (P/F) option for any one course as part of the 90 credit minimum, eligibility for honors at graduation will be lost.

Minimum required resident graded credits reduced to 75.

Honors at graduation are awarded with a minimum of 90 Seattle University graded credits and a cumulative GPA as follows:

Magna Cum Laude	3.70 to 3.89
Summa Cum Laude	3.90 to 4.00

Students graduating between September 1975 and August 1988 were awarded honors on the following scale:

Cum Laude	3.40 with at least 90 SU graded credit

Summa Cum Laude	3.90 with at least 90 SU graded credit
