I. Definitions – Instructional Delivery Modes

Hybrid Course: A course where at least 30% of the traditional face-to-face class time is replaced by online learning activities. Students enrolled in hybrid courses must be available for on-campus sessions. A hybrid course is also known as a “blended course”.

Online Course: A for-credit or non-credit course where ³ number of instructor-student and student-student interactions.

II. Course Section Size

Each section of an online course must be reviewed by the dean in consultation with the standards related to fully & Innovation (CDLI) is required to review all online courses. Courses undergoing review must have all materials (e.g., content pages, discussion board structure) are finished and available in the LMS before the course is taught. The review process must be approved by CDLI.

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
