Suspension, and Reinstatement Policy for Undergraduate Stuttleist College of Nursingpolicy describes additional conditions for admission progression academic warning, probation duspension for students in the Bachelor Science Nursing (BSN) and Diagnostic Ultrasour (DIUS) programs.

I. Admission

- A. Freshman Admission In addition to the university admission standards, all applicants to the College of Nursing traditional *Jear BSN program must have a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of at least 2.75 (on a 4.00 scale), and two units of laboratory science, one each in laboratory chemistry and laboratory biology. All applicants to the Diagnostic Ultrasound (DIUS) program must have a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of at least 2.75 (on a 4.00 scale), and two units of laboratory science, one each in laboratory chemistry and laboratory physics.
- B. Transfer and PostBaccalaureate Admission:For transfer students applying to the program or DIUS program from other regionally accredited colleges or universities, admission requirements include receipt by the Seattle University Office of Admissions of an official transcriptverifying completion of prerequisite courses. Additionally, transfer applicants must meet the following criteria for entry into the nursing course sequence:
 - i) transferof 90 credits, per University Policy #20042, Admission to the University
 - ii) a gradeof at least C (2.00 on the decimal system) in each nursing major prerequisite course and in each DS prerequisite course.
 - iii) a cumulativeGPA of at least2.75 and a 3. GPA in all nursing and DIUS prerequisite courses.
- C. Internal Transfers: CurrentSU student equests for internal ansfer to the nursing or DIUS major will be considered on aspacævailable basis. Qualified applicants who wish to change their major to nursing or DIUS must meet the freshmar admission criteria outlined above.

II. Progression

A. For SU traditional 4year students and internal transfer students to begin the nursing sequence courses (NURS) r DIUS sequence courses, a student rootstplete all UCOR and nursing or DIUS

- courses, without recommendation of the progression committee and/or the approval of the Associate Dean.
- D. A student who takes fewer than the required nursing IUS credits for the specified program of study will be considered 'out of sequence ourses are not offered very quarter, which will affect the timing of re-entry and program completion. Outsequence students will allowed to

 - (e) American Registry for Diagnostic Medical Sonography, Inc. (ARDMS)
 - (f) American Institute of Ultrasound in Medicine (AIUM)
 - (g) Cardiovascular Credentialing International (CCI)
 - (h) Society for Vascular Ultrasound (SVU)
 - (i) American Society of Echocardiography (ASE)
