Seattle University estimates that, at the time the university distributed its Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students under CRRSAA, and during the period of April 1, 2021, through June 30, 2021, when the university distributed \$500 under ARP, approximately 6800 of its students were eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students under CRRSAA and ARP.
5. Seattle University distributed Emergency Financial Aid Grants to 1,995 students under CRRSAA. Seattle has distributed Emergency Financial Aid Grants to one (1) student under ARP.
6. Seattle University established a committee to oversee the distribution of CARES Act Emergency Financial Aid Grants. The same committee oversaw distribution of CRRSAA Emergency Financial Aid Grants and ARP Emergency Financial Aid Grants. The committee examined student financial data to establish a formula for funding grants. For the period of July 1, 2021, through September 30, 2021, the committee authorized (and the university distributed): one (1) grant of \$500 based on the student's financial circumstances, including the student's expected family contribution.
